

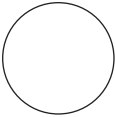
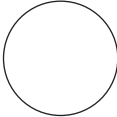
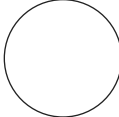
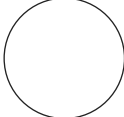
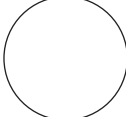
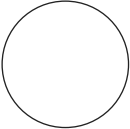
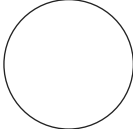
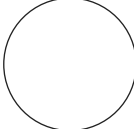
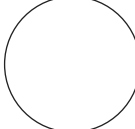
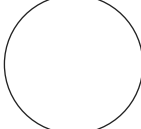
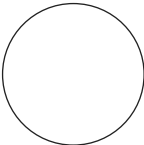
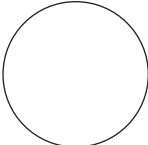
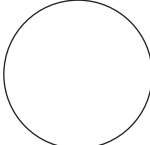
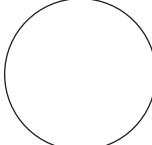
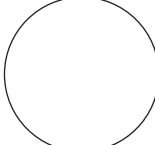
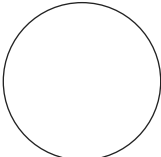
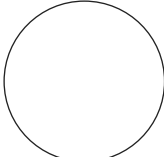
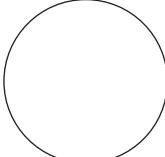
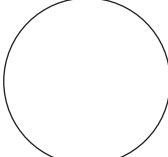
Find your ring size

US Letter / Print at 100% or Actual Size

Select the matching paper size and turn off Fit to Page before printing.
Check the line below with a ruler. It must measure exactly 50 mm.
If it does not, correct the print settings before using this guide.



Use a ring that fits the same finger comfortably.
Match its inside edge to the outside edge of a printed circle.
The upper label is the US size. The lower label is the inside diameter.
